Virginia Hudson Baker was born November 10, 1956 in Eatonton, Georgia to the parentage of Hattie Hudson and Johnny Terry.

She was educated in the Eatonton and Atlanta Public School systems, graduating from J.C. Murphy High School in 1974. After several years in the workforce, Virginia sought higher educational pursuits, ultimately obtaining a master's degree in business administration from St. Leo University.

In 1982, Virginia joined in holy matrimony with Michael Baker and to this union, one son, her pride and joy, Markus, was born. When she married Michael, she also gained her bonus son, Michael Stafford.

At an early age, Virginia attended Thankful Baptist Church (Decatur, GA). When she married, she joined Welcome Friend Baptist Church (Atlanta, GA) under the pastorate of Rev. J.H. Smith, Sr. and years later, she became a member of Voices of Faith Church under the leadership of Bishop Gary Hawkins.

Virginia joined the Atlanta Police Department in 1980 and served for 30 years. Well respected throughout the field of law enforcement, she achieved the rank of lieutenant before retiring in 2010.
